

# CAMPING CHECKLIST

## Things to Bring (or Consider)

---

### Shelter Items

- Tent
- Tent stakes, cords
- Ground Cloth (tarp to place under tent)
- Rain Fly
- Extra tarps
- Rope / twine
- Camp chairs
- Dining Canopy
- Sleeping bag
- Mattress Pads
- Air mattress / pump
- Pillows
- Blanket / sheets for summer

### Cooking / Dining

- Folding table
- Camp Stove (No liquid "white" fuel stoves)
- Propane/Fuel cylinders
- Charcoal
- Chimney starter
- Firewood / kindling / paper
- Matches / lighter
- Cooking surface (Grate)
- Grill and cooking utensils (Spatula / tongs / grill brush)
- Pots / pans / percolator (filters, coffee)
- Cutting board, knives
- Mixing /serving bowls, containers
- Silverware/Plastic utensils
- Cups (Hot/Cold)
- Paper plates, napkins
- Paper towels
- Dish tubs (hot/soap; cold/rinse)
- Dish soap / pads / brillo pad
- Marshmallow sticks/skewers
- Cooler / blue ice / ice
- Table cloths
- Trash bags
- Food
- Beverages (no alcohol allowed)
- S'mores (coordinate with Den)
- Snacks (granola bars, chips, etc.)
- Water

### Special clothes (Consider planned activities)

- Hiking boots
- Sneakers
- Jeans / Pants / Shorts
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Swim suit, Towel
- Socks
- Raincoat / parka
- Jacket / Windbreaker
- Scout Uniform – Class A (if indicated)
- Scout Uniform – Class B (t-shirt)
- Plastic Bag for soiled/wet clothing

### Hygiene

- Toiletries (Shampoo, Deodorant)
- Medicines
- Bath towels, washcloth
- Toothbrush / toothpaste
- Flip flops / slip-on shoes (shower)
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent (with low-level DEET)
- First aid kit, Insect bite/rash creams
- Toilet paper

### Camping Gear

- Water bottle (refillable)
- Lantern (No liquid "white" fuel lanterns)
- Flashlights, Headlamps
- Extra batteries
- Folding camp saw
- Refillable Water containers
- Light backpack
- Hydration pack (for hikes, rides)
- Scout handbook
- Walking stick
- Knife (only with Whittling Chip card)
- Compass
- Binoculars
- Fishing gear / bait
- Bike, tire pump, helmet, lock
- Misc. ropes, bungee cords
- Hammer
- Dust pan & brush (to clean out tent)
- Sports equipment (balls, Frisbee, etc.)
